

## TRANSPORTS

Piraeus, the port of Athens, is about 8 km away from the city centre.

### By Metro:

#### From Athens International Airport:

Take **Line 3 (blue)**, which links the airport to Monastiraki Station, and then switch to **Line 1** to Piraeus. The trip between the airport and Piraeus takes about 75 min and costs 6€. You can then reach the Conference Venue by taxi or by foot.

#### From the city center:

- **From Monastiraki Station:** this is where **Line 3 (blue)** intersects with Line 1; take **Line 1 (green)** to Piraeus;
- **From Omonoia Station:** this is where **Line 2 (red)** intersects with Line 1; again, take **Line 1 (green)** to Piraeus;
- **From Syntagma Station:** take **Line 3 (blue)** to Monastiraki and then **Line 1 (green)** to Piraeus.

Note: A single ticket costs 1€ and allows for an unlimited number of trips within 90 minutes after validation.

### By Bus:

From the airport, take the X96 bus route (3,20€ fare) to arrive (after 60-80 minutes) at the centre of Piraeus. **Venizelou** (Labraki str.) and **Dimotiko** are the two stops closest to the conference Venue.

Or, from the center of Athens:

- **Bus 049**, from Omonoia square;
- **Bus 040**, from Syntagma square (night bus).

### By Taxi:

A trip to Piraeus takes around 50min and costs 40-50€.
